

(WASHINGTON) – Today **Congressman John B. Larson** called on the House Republican leadership to pass the middle-class tax cut. Earlier today, the United States Senate voted to extend tax cuts for middle-class families without adding unnecessary tax breaks for the top 2% of Americans.

"With the Senate's action today, the only thing standing in the way of a tax cut for middle-class families and American small businesses is the House Republican majority," said Congressman Larson. Middle-class families are counting on us to do the right thing. They deserve nothing less."
